	Food and drink – Visitors are advised not to bring food and drink to the stadium as there will be sufficient provision inside for purchase.



All ticketholders are now prohibited from bringing any bag into the stadium unless it is smaller than an A4 piece of paper

Bag Policy

- Wembley Stadium operates a restricted bag policy
- Bags larger than an A4 piece of paper will not be permitted entry
- If you need to bring certain items or equipment for medical reasons, please visit https://help.wembleystadium.com/support/home before event day to request a medical exemption certificate which you will need to bring with you.
- All event day merchandise purchased from Wembley Stadium Store will be supplied in clear plastic bags and will still be admissible
- The new restricted bag policy has been introduced to further enhance public safety and to make accessibility on event days much more efficient. The new policy will enable guests to move through the stadium turnstiles much faster and benefit from enhanced safety inside and outside the stadium. ALCOHOL

No alcohol will be permitted entry if brought to the stadium. Full concessions will be available inside the stadium including alcohol to be purchased with the following management plan in place:

- Alcohol is permitted inside the bowl
- 4 x drinks per person at time of service
- All drinks will have their tops removed at service points.
- Challenge 25 will be in force
- All soft drinks brought to the stadium will have their tops removed.

GUEST SERVICES

Connectors

Connectors are the dedicated team to ensure all guests to Wembley Stadium have a positive and memorable experience. They will be conveniently located throughout the venue and at Wembley Park station wearing bright yellow. This team are in place to provide support and knowledge to enhance the experience of all guests and ensure they can locate their seat, gate or transport hub. If you seek advice or assistance on event day, please locate a Connector.

Accessible shuttle

There will be an accessible shuttle operating between Wembley Park Tube Station and Wembley Stadium that can be utilised by any high needs guests. Wheelchair users, families with young children or anyone with difficulty walking long distances are encouraged to utilise this service.

The shuttle will be operational between 17:30 – 24:00

Young Person Wristbands

As a safeguarding service, Wembley Stadium provides 'Young Visitor Wristbands' to assist in the event of a lost child. To collect a young visitor wristband please visit your nearest information point.

Re-Entry

Should spectators leave the Stadium, they will \underline{not} be allowed to re-enter, unless under exceptional circumstances such as on medical grounds. Please seek the support of a safety steward if this situation arises.

Please note Wembley Stadium is a public transport destination and is well catered for with public services, which is the recommended mode of transport to and from the stadium. Below is a list of transport options for guests:

TRAIN AND TUBE

London Underground

- Wembley Park Tube 5 mins walk from stadium (Metropolitan Line direct to Baker Street / Jubilee Line direct to Baker Street and Bond Street)
- Wembley Central Tube 15 mins walk from stadium (Bakerloo Line direct to Marylebone, Baker Street and Oxford Circus)

London Overground

 Wembley Stadium Station – 5 mins walk from stadium (Chiltern Railways direct to London Marylebone)

COACH

National Express is the Official Coach Supplier for Wembley Stadium connected by EE and provides dedicated links for visitors to the stadium. Book your coach tickets for match day from over 55 locations across the UK by visiting NationalExpress or by calling 08717 81 81 81.

CAR

For supporters wishing to drive please note there will be very limited spaces available at the stadium. Therefore we would strongly advise the use of public transport. If parking is required please book well in advance via Wembley Official Parking to guarantee your parking space.

Blue badge parking is available to purchase via Wembley Official Parking.

Please note that local road closures will be in place around the stadium on event day approximately 4 hours prior to show start so plan travel accordingly.

TRAVEL

BUS

Local buses to the Stadium include 18, 83, 92 and 224.

Please note that London buses no longer accept cash, therefore any supporters travelling by bus will need to pay for the fare using an Oyster card or contact less payment card. A single adult fare is £1.45.

DROP OFF COLLECTION MEETING POINT

For all concerts at Wembley Stadium there is a designated pedestrian Meeting Point located at Market Square(next to the Brent Civic Centre), this will be clearly signposted. Access to the stadium concourse is restricted to ticket holders only, therefore if you need to wait for friends or family before or after the show we strongly recommend you do so here. The meeting point is within walking distance to all car parks and transport connections.

A useful map is included at the end of this guide to help locate the Meeting Point.


Yellow Car Park is the designated Drop Off / Collection Point for this event.

Directions

Club Wembley members should make their way to any of the Club Wembley entrances situated on the North, East and West of the Stadium.

From Wembley Park Station

As you approach the Stadium along Olympic Way, you will reach the pedestrian walkway. For all General Admission tickets please use the elevated walk way to reach the turnstiles. Club Wembley Members should remain on the street level and enter via the Club Wembley Main Entrance.

From Wembley Stadium and Wembley Central Stations

From Wembley Central, turn right out of the station and walk down the High Road. Turn left at the triangle, towards Wembley Stadium Station. Cross White Horse Bridge and turn right onto South Way. Follow the path up to the main concourse. Club Wembley Members will see the Club Wembley West entrance here.

From the Yellow Car Park

Either enter via the Club Wembley main entrance at street level or make your way up to the main concourse (Level 1). From here you can enter via the North. East or West entrances.

From the Red Car Park

Approach the Stadium along Royal Route and make your way up to the main concourse (Level 1). From here the nearest Club Wembley entrance is the West entrance.

From the Pink Car Park

Come out the car park and turn left on the main road and walk towards the stadium
